- Care for colonies of cats in Crossville or Fairfield Glade – Volunteers take 1 day a week to feed
- Maintain upkeep of feeding stations and shelters 1-2 times a year
- Help trap cats who need to be neutered/spayed
- Foster – care for kittens or cats (some recovering from surgery) in your home
- Rescue & Rehabilitation Center (R&R) – help care for cats in the center 1 morning a week (feed, scoop litter box, clean kennel, socialize)
- Cat socialization/care – travel to cat foster homes to socialize and play with cats to get them ready for a forever home
- Transport – drive cats to vet appointments or spay/neuter clinics
