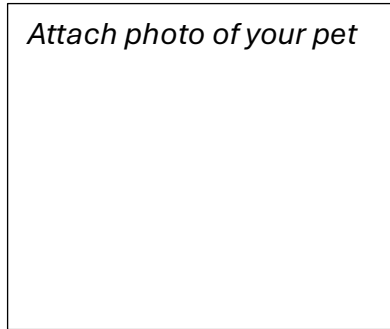


In Case of Emergency

Who would take care of your pet(s) if you were hurt and unable to do so? Ensure vital information regarding your pet is easily accessible to others, especially emergency personnel, by taking a few moments to fill out this **emergency pet information sheet**.

List two or three people as contacts in case of emergency, and make sure at least one of the contacts has a set of your house keys.

Keep this in a prominent location in your house, and give copies to neighbors, friends or relatives who will be caring for your pet if you cannot.
